

## JOIN OUR LOCAL FARM

Out of the Garden Project's Urban Teaching Farm grows fresh vegetables and herbs on three acres at Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in the Warnersville neighborhood in Greensboro. Our goal is to improve access to fresh foods, offer service learning opportunities and teach the sustainable skill of farming to the next generation in our community. To support our mission, we are offering memberships in our Harvest Box program! Memberships for 2019 are available on a limited basis -- first-come, first-served -- for a suggested donation of **\$500**. We also have a limited number of **Pay What You Can** Harvest Box shares available.

# WHAT'S IN THE BOX

As a member you will receive:

- Weekly local and sustainably grown produce from April 17th-October 9th. Each box includes **4-8 different kinds of vegetables and is valued at \$21**. You'll receive the best and freshest of what's available on the farm that week.

- Invitations to **monthly community dinners** at the farm.

- An invite to our end of season **Fall Harvest Day Celebration** in October.



#### YOUR WEEKLY SHARE

When you sign up to be a member of our Harvest Box program you agree to pick up your box of fresh produce each week from April 17th-October 9th (with a one week break in August). Pick up is on:

If you are unable to make a pick up, you are welcome to send someone else in your place that week. If no one picks up your Harvest Box, we will donate the produce through our programs.
